The objective of the Project is to strengthen public finance management reform implementation of the Recipient for increased accountability and efficient usage of public resources in the public sector. Part 1:Strengthen internal control practices in the public administrations

Provision of consultants' services and training and workshops to strengthen internal control practices by updating public internal financial control legislation, preparation of risk management manual, piloting of risk management manual in public administrations with different budgetary structures, revision of the manual after pilot studies and training of personnel of public administrations and design of risk management software for public administrations, preparation of user guide and training for trainers for central harmonization unit and strategic development units personnel on this issue.

Part 2: Development of the program classification and program structure for efficient budgeting. Provision of consultants' services and training and workshops; to design the programs and prepare program justifications including program performance information, to develop techniques for program costing, program monitoring, evaluation and reporting; and to enhance the administrative capacity of Ministry of Finance and public administrations by providing; i) training events on program development, design of performance information, budget negotiation techniques and awareness raising activities for managerial level; ii) prepare a web portal on program budgeting; iii) good practices paper including other country experiences.

Part 3: Strengthen accounting and financial reporting system in the public sector.

Provision of consultancy service to establish integrated commitment system within the framework

of information produced by means of detecting commitment and contingent liabilities, particularly

future social security liabilities, and then migrating these financial operations to the accounting

system; develop an electronic procurement model suggestion for public sector by gaining

information about electronic document and report formats; obtain information about criteria of

public administrations for preparing and publishing financial statements in structures in which

Unity of Treasury is implemented; obtain information about harmonization of national accounting

legislation to the IPSASs, recognition of underground resources and buildings on lands, as well as

international practices of IPSAS 32 (Service Concession Arrangements)
